Retailers and law enforcement personnel in a multi-state region have joined forces and resources to fight organized retail theft.

The **Law Enforcement Retailer Alliance of New England (LERANE)** is an information sharing network of law enforcement and retailers designed to combat organized retail theft. Driven by the Retail Merchants Association of New Hampshire, Retailers Association of Massachusetts, Connecticut Retail Merchants Association, Vermont Retailers Association, Rhode Island Retail Federation and the Maine Merchants Association, **LERANE** works with New England law enforcement, retailers and the Attorney Generals' Offices in New Hampshire, Massachusetts and Maine to get organized retail theft information out.

LERANE is a new era in fighting organized retail theft. This is a multi-state, multi-jurisdictional effort between retailers and law enforcement to share information on ORC as it is happening - an unprecedented alliance. Criminals are learning that New England is serious about stopping organized retail theft.
